



Fishing Game

Items Needed:

- ✓ Martelli Templates needed:
- ✓ * 3 piece small fish set
- ✓ 4 fat quarters primary color; red, blue, green, and yellow
- ✓ 1 quarter inch ribbon (Approximately 15" – 24")
- ✓ Size 8 metal washers (That can be picked up with a magnet)
- ✓ Hologram duct tape
- ✓ Poly fill
- ✓ 48" piece of cord
- ✓ 1 small eye screw (For dowel Rod)
- ✓ 24" Dowel Rod 5/8" diameter
- ✓ Hot Glue (Optional)
- ✓ Paper clips (Optional)
- ✓ Felt (Optional)
- ✓ Martelli Ring Magnet or any magnet will work

Instructions -

To create the Fishing Game:

1. Taking your fish templates, cut out two pieces of each size out of all 4 fat quarters.
2. You will have 8 fish pieces from each fat quarter to create a total of 12 fish 4 of each size.
3. Place fabric right sides together set aside.
4. Cut your ribbon into 1" or 1 ½" pieces.
5. Thread each piece through a metal washer and fold in half.
6. Place the ribbon with the washer inbetween the sandwich fish pieces at the nose.
7. Sew a quarter inch all the way around being sure to catch the ribbon and leave a 2" opening for turning.

8. Turn your fish right side out, the washer should be on the outside attached to the ribbon.
9. Lightly stuff the fish and sew closed.
10. If you are using felt cut out two pieces of felt per fish and glue the two pieces together with the paper clip glued between the two sandwiched pieces.
11. With your dowel rod and your hologram tape, cut a strip of the hologram tape 25" long and wrap it around your dowel rod length wise.
12. Take your string or cord and tie a knot then attach to the magnetic ring and the eye screw at the end of the dowel rod.
