



Game Board Tic Tac Toe and Bull's Eye

Items Needed:

- ✓ Martelli Templates needed:
- ✓ * 8 ½ inch square
- ✓ * 19 inch circle
- ✓ * 9 inch circle
- ✓ * Orange peel template with fussy cut
- ✓ 1 yard fabric blue
- ✓ ½ yard fabric plus 10 inch square of White
- ✓ ½ yard fabric black
- ✓ 20 X 20 inch square fabric yellow
- ✓ 10 X 10 inch square fabric red
- ✓ 2 pieces of ½ yard of fabric for bean bags—need two colors
- ✓ 2 yards fusible fleece (optional)
- ✓ Fusible glue or basting spray (optional)
- ✓ Poly beads or rice

Instructions -

To make the Tic Tac Toe game board:

1. Cut 9 squares with the 8 ½ inch square with the white fabric.
2. With the black fabric, cut 2 inch strips width of fabric. You will need about 6-7 strips. Subcut strips. You will need 6 -8 ½ in strips. 4-27 inch strips and 2- 30 inch strips.
3. Sew the 6 short strips on 2 sides of 3 white squares.
4. Add 2 white squares on each end to make a row of 3 white squares and 2 black strips.
5. Take the 4- 27 inch strips and sew the 3 rows together, placing a black strip top, bottom and in between.
6. Add the 2- 30 inch strips on both side to frame it all in. It should finish to be 30 X 30 inches.
7. Add fusible fleece to the wrong side if so desired.

To make the Bull's Eye game board:

1. With the blue fabric cut 2 strips 3 inches width of fabric, this is for the straps (set aside).
2. Cut a 30 X 30 inch square, with remaining blue fabric.
3. Add fusible fleece to the back side of the fabric.
4. Using your yellow fabric and 19" circle template, cut a 19" circle.
5. Using your 10" square red fabric and 9" circle template, cut out a circle.
6. Center the red circle onto the yellow circle and applique or sew into place.
7. Center the yellow circle onto the center of the blue square and applique or sew into place.
8. With the blue straps sew them like you are creating a double fold binding. (Fold a quarter inch on each side and fold it in half, and press. Then sew down the side)
9. Fold each strap in half and stitch a line.

Instructions on how to put the two games above together:

1. Make sure they both measure at 30 X 30 inches, or trim to where they are all the same on all four sides for both pieces.
2. Place the tic tac toe game right side down on top of the bull's eye game which is right side up.
3. Sandwich the straps folded on one side of the board and clip into place.
4. Place clips all around your piece to hold it in place from slipping.
5. Sew 3/8 inch seam allowance all the way around leaving a 6 inch opening on one side. Be sure to back tack at the opening and back tack over the straps.
6. Find your opening and turn right side out, and then press.
7. Top stitch 1/8 inch all the way around closing the opening.

Instructions on how to create the beanbags:

1. Using the orange peel template and your two colors of fabric you will cut out 20 pieces of each color to create a total of five beanbags. (Each beanbag requires 4 pieces)
2. Sew two pieces together in pairs and then sew the pairs together leaving a 2" opening for turning it right side out and for filling the bag.
3. Fill each bag with about 1 cup of poly beads or rice.
4. Hand stitch or machine stitch the opening to close. (Be sure NOT to get any beads or rice under your machine needle)
