



REVERSIBLE BELL HAT

These instructions work for all three sizes (infant, toddler and child).

Items Needed:

- ✓ Bell Hat Template
- ✓ Outer fabric – two coordinating colors – Fat Quarter each
- ✓ Lining – one Fat Quarter
- ✓ Sewing machine

Instructions –

If you are using a pattern fabric, use fussy cut window and center. Place template inside and cut around. You will need a total of 6 pieces for the outside and 6 pieces for the lining. If you are using interfacing, you will need 6 pieces.

If using interfacing, fuse interfacing onto the wrong side outer of the main six pieces.

Sew in groups of three.

Once you have your set of 3 sewn, place 2 two sets together and sew those together. Repeat with the lining.

Place both lining and outer pieces together, right sides together. Sew all the way around the brim, leaving a 2” opening for turning right side out.

After turning, topstitch 1/8” all the way around the brim closing the opening.

OPTIONAL –

- Fusible interfacing enough to use for the outer fabric
- Add tie straps by creating a small buttonhole on both sides, attaching ribbons or ties.
- Flip up brim – attach buttons
