

# Ultimate Walker Bottle Holder

## **Materials List:**

- (1) 10"x14" Outer Fabric
  - (1) 10"x14" Lining Fabric
  - (1) 10"x14" Fusible Fleece
  - (1) 4"x8" Outer Fabric for Strap
- Iron on Velcro

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## **Assembly:**

Take 10"x14" outer fabric and iron on fusible fleece making sure fabric sticks well.

Quilt if desired.

Sew right sides together using 1/4" seam leaving top 14" end open.

Box the bottom corners of the bag 1.5" square from each corner.

Pull together where boxing is cut out and stitch across using 1/4" seam.

Cut corners of boxing to remove bulk. Be careful not to cut into stitching.

Take lining fabric and sew in the same manner except leaving an opening on long side so this can be pulled through later.

Box corners in same manner as mentioned above.

Take 4"x8" piece and fold right sides together to form a 2"x 8" long piece leaving a 2" opening to turn fabric right sides out later.

Sew all the way around the 2"x 8" piece leaving a 2" at one end open to turn fabric inside out.

Pull fabric through so that right sides are out.

Topstitch 1/8" the whole way around and close opening at this time.

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## **Completing the Bag:**

Place bag lining with right sides out into the bag lining matching up side seams. Make sure right sides are facing each other.

Insert strap between lining and outer fabric keeping it even with the top of the bag. Pin or clip 2"x8" strap into the center of bag to keep in place.

Sew 1/4" seam the whole way around the perimeter of the top of bag. There is an opening in side of the bag that it will be pulled through later.

Pull entire bag through the 4" opening. This may be difficult due to the fabric and Bosal. This will form a long tube.

Topstitch opening with 1/8" seam to close opening.

Push the lining of the bag into the outer bag being sure to match up corners.

Apply iron on Velcro to all four corners of bag.

Bag is complete!
